New Campus

- Indian School & 12th Street
 - Grades 6-10 will be located at the new site

Graduation Requirement

- NACA requires that students earn at-least 28 credits in order to graduate.
- 4 English, 4 Social Studies,4 Math, 4 Science, 4 Indigenous Core, 6 Electives, 1 Personal Wellness, 2 Languages
- Must complete 6 hours of dual enrollment courses at IAIA, UNM or CNM with a “C” or higher
- Apply for colleges and higher learning options
- Take PSAT, ACT, and participate fully in preparation programs Junior Year
- Pass the NMHGA or Alternative Demonstration of Competency prior to Graduation
- Successfully complete HS Graduation in 4 years
- Participate in all Advisory and School Service projects annually
- Plan social events for high school students such as Prom, Field Trips etc.
- If you are an athlete you must maintain grades of “C” or higher to participate and meet NM Athletics Association requirements.
- Work with Advisor and College Engagement Team to apply for summer enrichment and scholarship opportunities. Including successfully completing FAFSA workshops at NACA.

9th Grade

- Language (Navajo, Lakota etc)
- Algebra I
- Humanities (English 9 and NM History)
- Physics
- Personal Wellness
- Elective Option of NACA Rock, Arts and Media or Literacy Block or Study Hall

10th Grade

- Language (Navajo, Lakota etc)
- Geometry
- Humanities (English 10 and World History)
- Chemistry
- Public Speaking and Health
- Elective Option of NACA Rock, Arts and Media or Literacy Block or Study Hall
- Note: Students who want to take Dual Enrollment courses at UNM and CNM need to take the admissions assessments in November or December in order to sign up for courses.

Junior Year

- Language (Navajo, Lakota etc) as Elective or Dual Enrollment Course
- Algebra II
- Humanities (English 11 and US History)
- Biology
- Indigenous Studies/Junior Seminar
- Internship option for students who meet the GPA and Dual Enrollment Options at IAIA, UNM, CNM

Senior Year

- Language (Navajo, Lakota etc) Option
- Pre-Calculus and/or UNM Math Course
- Humanities (English 12 and Government/Economics)
- Environmental Science
- Senior Seminar and Dual Enrollment Options at UNM, CNM, IAIA
- Apply to at-least 5 schools if not 10
